Your promptness in responding will lighten Mr. Elliott's task of preparing a satisfactory program for the Saturday afternoon paper session.

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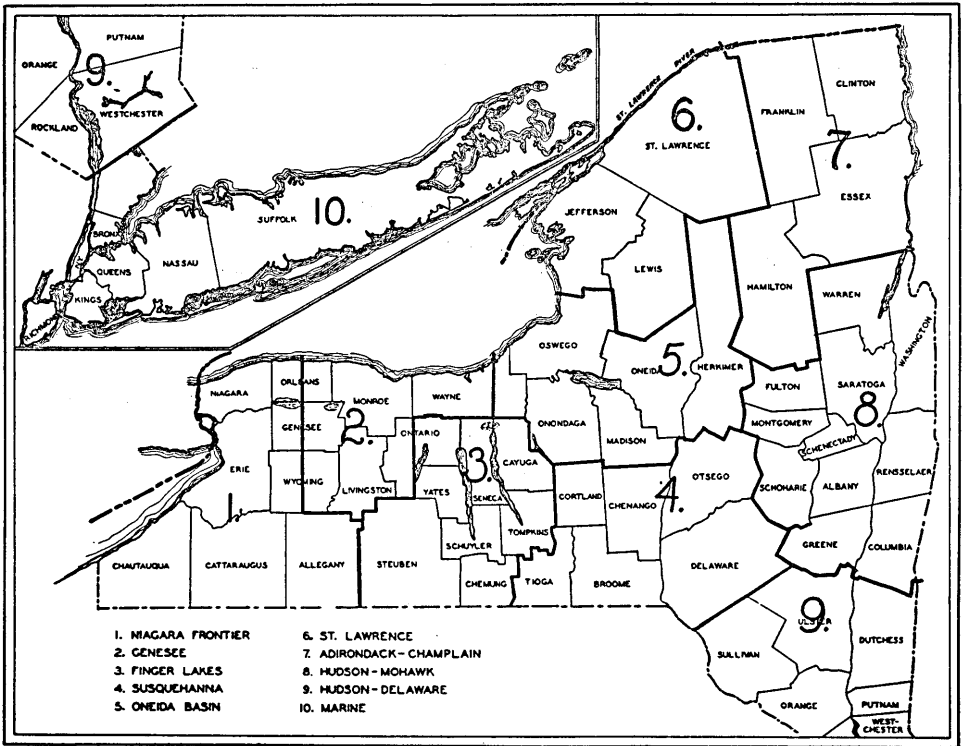
