

THE 105TH CHRISTMAS BIRD COUNT IN NEW YORK STATE

The data below were collected and edited by a team of volunteers from throughout the state, as well as many individual compilers. Boldface indicates unusual species or unusually high counts; parentheses indicate data from the online database which differ from data submitted directly by compilers. For example, many counts included participants who declined to pay the fee and were thus not named or counted in the database. When known, these observers are included here, followed by the lower, official number in parentheses.
