

REGION 3—FINGER LAKES

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September and October were warmer and wetter than normal in the Region. November was colder and drier than normal. In Ithaca, the average low temperature in September was 51.6° F, 2.8° above normal. The average high temperature was 73.0°, 1.4° above normal. Total rainfall was 5.23", 1.4" more than normal. Cold fronts passed through on 2, 11, 20, 24, and 30 September. The average low temperature in October was 47.1°, 8.2° above normal. The average high was 64.3°, 5.3° above normal. Total rainfall was 7.35", 3.65" more than normal. Cold fronts passed through on 4, 10, 17, 23, 27, and 30 October. In November, the average low temperature was 28.5°, 1.9° below normal. The average high temperature was 46.1°, 0.7° below normal. Total precipitation was 2.61", 0.25" less than normal. Total snowfall was 3.7", 0.9" less than normal. Maximum snow depth was 2.0" attained on 29 November. Cold fronts passed through on 3, 11, 14, 20, 23, and 27 November.

The migration of geese and swans through the Region began with the early arrival of two Mute Swans in early September. Two Cackling Geese arrived in mid-September. The arrival of Brant in mid-October was widely observed in the Cayuga Lake Basin. The first Tundra Swans also arrived in mid-October. The first Greater White-fronted Goose appeared in late October. Migrating Snow Geese with at least one Ross's Goose arrived in early November. A high count of Canada Geese was at Montezuma National Wildlife Refuge (NWR) in mid-November. A very rare **Barnacle Goose** also appeared in mid-November.

Fall duck arrivals began with a Red-breasted Merganser and a flock of Surf Scoters in late September. A Common Goldeneye and a White-winged Scoter showed up in early October. The first Bufflehead, Canvasbacks and Black Scoters arrived in mid-October and a Long-tailed Duck appeared in late October. The only high count was for Northern Pintails at Montezuma NWR in late November.

The first Horned Grebe report was from late October. The only report of Red-necked Grebes came from the Geneva Country Club in early November. Migrating Sandhill Cranes continued to gather in increasing numbers at Montezuma NWR with a high count of 200 in late October.

Shorebird arrivals during the season were American Golden-Plover, Semipalmated Plover, Stilt Sandpiper, and Buff-breasted Sandpiper in early September, Dunlin in mid-September, Hudsonian Godwit in late September, and Red Phalarope in late November. There was a high count of Lesser Yellowlegs at Montezuma NWR in early November and a late-lingering Spotted Sandpiper in mid-November.

Gull arrivals were Lesser Black-backed Gull in early September, Sabine's Gull in late September, Iceland Gull in mid-November, and an early Glaucous

Gull in mid-November. The first Red-throated Loon of the season was reported in late October. A **Pacific Loon** was on Cayuga Lake in late November.

The **Roseate Spoonbill** that originally appeared at Montezuma NWR in July continued there through mid-September. A Glossy Ibis arrived in mid-September and lingered into mid-October. There was a high count of Great Egrets at Montezuma NWR in mid-October.

A high count of Turkey Vultures migrated past Liddell Lab and Ponds in late October. At least one Black Vulture lingered at the Stevenson Road Compost Piles through the end of the season. The **Swallow-tailed Kite** that first showed up in Yates County in August stayed there through mid-September. An early Golden Eagle was at Montezuma NWR in mid-September. The first report of a Rough-legged Hawk was in late October.

A Long-eared Owl was detected in the Town of Erin in mid-October. Short-eared Owls first appeared in the Town of Phelps in early November and a high count of them was there in late November. The first Snowy Owl arrived in mid-November.

A high count of Eastern Kingbirds was reported at Hile School Road Wetland in early September. An Olive-sided Flycatcher observed in late September was late to depart. Counts of Warbling Vireos at Hog Hole in early September and of Philadelphia Vireos in Palmer woods in mid-September were high.

There were high counts of Brown Creepers at Danby State Forest in early September and of White-breasted Nuthatches at Mundy Wildflower Garden in mid-November. A Sedge Wren was at Bluegrass Lane Natural Area in early to mid-September. A Gray Catbird lingered at Stony Brook State Park into late November. The arrival of a Gray-cheeked Thrush on 4 September was early. An American Pipit arrived in mid-September.

A count of House Sparrows at East Lawn Cemetery in late October was high. A few winter finches arrived during the season: Pine Siskins in early September, White-winged Crossbills and Common Redpolls in early November, and Red Crossbills in mid-November. A dozen Lapland Longspurs arrived in the Town of Fayette in mid-October and were also a high count. A Snow Bunting arrived in late October.

A Lincoln's Sparrow arrived early on 1 September. A Rusty Blackbird arrived in mid-September, a Fox Sparrow and White-crowned Sparrows in late September, a Nelson's Sparrow in early October, and an American Tree Sparrow in mid-October. A **Lark Sparrow** was discovered in the Town of Tyre in mid-September. There was a high count of Swamp Sparrows at the Seneca Meadows Wetland Preserve in early October and of Vesper Sparrows at Bluegrass Lane Natural Area in late October.

The first Orange-crowned Warbler arrived in mid-September. A high count of Bay-breasted Warblers was at Palmer Woods in early September. A high count of Hooded Warblers was at Turkey Hill in mid-September. A high count of Blackpoll Warblers was at Seneca Lake State Park in late September.
