Autumn 2021 had a precipitation surplus, especially in the southern half of Region 8. Temperatures were near normal in September and November, but October was well above normal. Migrant songbirds lingered later than usual and half-hardies seemed abundant and widespread. The first freeze at Albany did not occur until 2 November, and the first measurable snow was 26 November.

Razorbill was the ‘Bird of the Season’ in Region 8. Numerous observers on both the New York and Vermont sides of Lake Champlain reported one or more Razorbills starting in early November, to the north of the Region. On 18 November one was spotted just after dawn from Bob & Betty Cummings Memorial Park in extreme northeastern Washington County. Later in the morning, what was presumably the same individual was seen flying south along the narrow southern end of the lake from Clemons Marsh north of Whitehall, Washington County.

Two **White-eyed Vireos** were seen and photographed near Colonie Mohawk River Park in Albany County on 24 October. Rather than being an infrequent Spring ‘overshoot’, this species seems to show up during fall migration in this area. A **Stilt Sandpiper** was discovered in a flooded, recently manured farm field in Selkirk, Albany County on 17 October. One of the harder-to-find shorebirds in the Region, the most recent record before this was from 2017. Another Stilt Sandpiper was seen at Clemons Marsh in Washington County on 26 September. **Cattle Egrets** were observed in several locations this fall, part of a large incursion/dispersal into the northeastern states. Two Cattle Egrets were photographed near Ancram, Columbia County on 18 October. Singletons were observed near Athens, Greene County on 6 November, and at Tomhannock Reservoir in Rensselaer County on 20 November. The latter bird was discovered

perched above the water in an old cormorant nest. A **Mississippi Kite** was observed from Black Creek Marsh in Albany County, circling overhead, and moving off to the south. A **Yellow-breasted Chat** was seen near the Columbia County Airport in Ghent on 8 October. Finally, in one of the more unusual occurrences of the fall, Tristan Lowery found two (presumably not the same bird) **Dickcissels**, five days and about five miles apart. The first was at Normanskill Farm in the City of Albany, 2 October, and the second was at the former Bender Melon Farm property in New Scotland, Albany County, 7 October.

A **Barnacle Goose** showed up in a flock of Canada Geese at Cobleskill Reservoir in Schoharie County on 6 October. An observer at Hudson Crossing Park in Saratoga County on 30 October reported a flyover **Tundra Swan**, identified by flight call.

A lone **Canvasback** was reported from the Tomhannock Reservoir in Rensselaer County on 4 November, the only report of that species in Region 8 this autumn. **Redheads** were hardly more plentiful, with two seen at Basic Creek Reservoir in Albany County on 21 October, and a single female at Saratoga Lake, Saratoga County on 26 November.

Bill Cook reported a **Sandhill Crane** was seen at the Columbia County Airport near Ghent on 15 November. **Black-bellied Plover** was a nice late shorebird at Cohoes Flats in Albany County, seen on 29-30 September. A **Baird's Sandpiper** was photographed at Bob & Betty Cummings Memorial Park in Washington County on 12 September. At Lasher Park in Germantown, Columbia County, a **Ruddy Turnstone** was photographed on 9 September. A **Common Tern** and five 'sterna' sp. were observed along the Hudson River south of Germantown, Columbia County on 17 September.

A very late **Worm-eating Warbler** was sighted at Five Rivers Environmental Education Center on 23 September.

Bob Yunick shared some interesting observations, as always, in his Fall 2021 Field Notes, excerpted here:

“The following are observations from my feeding/banding locations in the Schenectady, NY area: **1)** feeder in my yard (**yard**) at Schenectady, and my Adirondack feeding/banding operation at **Jenny Lake (JL)** at 1250 ft. elev. 5 mi W of the Village of Corinth in the Town of Corinth, Saratoga Co, NY; **2)** raptor banding locations in the Towns of Florida (**TF**) and Glen (**TG**) in Montgomery Co (**MC**), NY, and in the Town of Ft. Edward (**FE**), Washington Co, NY and Town of Northumberland (**NUL**), Saratoga Co, NY; **3)** Tomhannock Res. (**TR**) near Pittstown, Rensselaer Co, NY.

1) Purple Finch breeding season at JL featured a welcomed uptick in numbers captured, but also a marked increase in conjunctivitis. Total captures were 198: 171 banded and 27 returns from previous years, the oldest of which were a M and F 7 yrs old. The banding total was enhanced by an unexpected 94 imm, the largest catch since 105 in 2012

and compared to 20 banded in 2020 and 6 each in 2019 and 2018. The 52-yr trend at JL of banding this bird which prefers cool forest habitat has been downward due to warming climate. Last banding on 9/11, after a massive exodus by 9/4 and last capture on 9/26.

2) Ruby-thr Hummer season at JL ended with last bird banded 9/17, seen again 9/18, later than usual, a total 49 banded, only 5 return captures (much lower than usual) for a total of 54 birds. While numbers of birds captured annually has varied up and down, the trend line for this species is unfortunately downward from a peak in 2003 when 185 birds were captured (bandings + returns) and sugar water consumption that year was 30,495 g compared to this year's 6514 g.

3) Snow Goose 62 in a cut cornfield at NUL with 260 **Canadas** 11/28; 595 Canadas MC 11/18, and only 412 Canadas 11/9 at TR where double or triple that should have been seen. A possible cause in the decline at TR was a newly practiced corn harvesting procedure which we observed at TR. The numerous corn fields round the reservoir were cut flush to the ground, something I've never seen before, compared to prior harvesting that cut stalks 15-18" high leaving spilled corn to attract geese. Every flush-cut field, and there were many, were devoid of geese."

230 species were recorded in Region 8 during the period.
