Temperatures were near normal in March and May in eastern upstate New York, while April was much warmer than normal. There were one-inch-plus surpluses of precipitation in March and April, and a significant deficit of more than fifty percent of normal rainfall in May.

As many as four **Greater White-fronted Geese** were observed in mid-March around Region 8, in Albany, Schenectady, and Rensselaer Counties. A **Tundra Swan** was present for several days in a cornfield and pond along Rt. 30 north of Blenheim in Schoharie County, also in mid-March. Drew Hopkins found an apparent **Eurasian x American Wigeon** hybrid at Vosburgh Marsh WMA on 19 March.

Pat Dollard had a **White-winged Dove** at his Albany home on 24-26 May and was very generous in letting visitors attempt to view the bird from the comfort of his backyard and deck. This bird appeared in his yard less than two weeks after he photographed a **Red-headed Woodpecker** at his suet feeder.

Six reports of **Sandhill Crane** were noted this spring, with a flock of nine reported at Drowned Lands Swamp Conservation Area in Columbia County on 18 March topping the list.

Upland Sandpiper was observed again this May in a traditional breeding location at a horse farm near Ames, Montgomery County. A **Red-necked Phalarope** was photographed on 23 April at the Schoharie Crossing State Historic Site in Montgomery County, where Schoharie Creek joins the Mohawk River. Gary Chapin detected a **Little Gull** flying north with a group of Bonaparte's Gulls at the north end of Lake George in Warren County, seen from Peggy's Point in Hague on 6 April. Mr. Chapin's lake watching continued to reap rewards on 3 May when he discovered seven **Black-legged Kittiwakes** flying southward along the narrower southern end of Lake Champlain. He viewed them from Bob & Betty Cummings Memorial Park in the Town of Wright. His was one of many inland sightings of the species during the first half of May, with some being noted as far west as Lake Erie, and even one report from Chicago on Lake Michigan.

An **American White Pelican** was a one-hour wonder along the Hudson River south of Albany on 31 May, first observed perched atop a boulder on the 358

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western side of the river north of Coeymans Landing, then from Schodack Island State Park as it flew overhead traveling northeastward. A **Western Cattle Egret** was photographed foraging along the towpath at Vischer Ferry Nature and Historic Preserve in Saratoga County on 18 May. Four **Glossy Ibis** were seen flying west up the Mohawk River from Vischer Ferry NHP on 18 April, while two others, presumably different birds, were photographed foraging in the wet fields along Staats Island Rd. in Schodack, Rensselaer County on 24 April. A **Swallow-tailed Kite** was seen flying overhead, and video obtained of the bird, in Altamont, Albany County on 6 May. This was one of several reports of the species in New England and eastern New York during the first week of May.

There was one report of **Acadian Flycatcher** this spring in Region 8, from Lake Taghkanic State Park in Columbia County on 28 May. A single observation of **Bicknell's Thrush** was reported, also on 28 May, from Hunter Mountain in Greene County. **Clay-colored Sparrow** was noted in Fort Plain, Montgomery County; in Fort Ann, Washington County; and at the Albany Pine Bush Preserve in Albany County.

240 species were reported during the period.
